Method and place of processing of the collected data

Treatment methods

The Owner implements appropriate security measures to prevent unauthorized access, disclosure, modification, or destruction of personal data.

Place

Retention period

The data is processed and stored for the time required by the purposes for which it was collected. Therefore:

- Personal data collected for purposes related to the legitimate interests of the Data Controller will be retained until such interests are satisfied. The User can obtain further information regarding the legitimate interest pursued by the Data Controller in the relevant sections of this document or by contacting the Data Controller.

When processing is based on the User's consent, the Data Controller may retain the personal data until such consent is revoked, and in any case, it may not exceed ten years (from their last use). Furthermore, the Data Controller may be obliged to retain the personal data for a longer period in compliance with a legal obligation, by order of an authority, or in the case of legal disputes, for the entire duration of such disputes, until the terms for appealing have been exhausted. At the end of the retention period, the personal data will be deleted. Therefore, after this period, the rights of access, deletion, rectification, and data portability can no longer be exercised.

Moderation

How to exercise your rights

To exercise their rights, Users may submit a request to the contact details of the Data Controller provided in this document. Requests can be made free of charge and will be processed by the Data Controller as soon as possible, and in any case within one month. If the request is particularly complex, the response time may be extended by an additional 60 days.

Applicability of the higher level of protection

While most of the provisions in this document apply to all Users, some are expressly subject to a higher level of protection regarding the processing of Personal Data.

This higher level of protection is always guaranteed when the processing:

- is performed by a Data Controller based in the EU; or

- concerns Personal Data of Users located in the EU and enables the Data Controller to monitor the behavior of such Users, provided that this behavior occurs within the Union.
